Parents will learn to teach the power and process of communication as a means to help their child connect with others and the environment more effectively.

The challenging behaviours, which may be associated with ASD, will be discussed. This will then be followed by practical examples and strategies for positive behaviour management. This training session will provide participants with information on how aspects of ASD can give rise to behaviour that challenges and suggest strategies for the prevention and management of such behaviour.
