



The Health and Safety Authority is working to create a National Culture of Excellence in Workplace Safety, Health and Welfare in Ireland.

The Authority is the state sponsored body in Ireland with responsibility for securing safety, health and welfare at work and operates under the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act, 2005.

The Authority has established a panel of tutors with formal health and safety qualifications as well as knowledge and experience of teaching in first or second level schools. We are now seeking new applicants for this panel. The panel of tutors will offer relevant instruction to teachers (including principals) on current occupational health and safety regulations. This instruction will be offered through the established in-service network.

Members of the panel must meet the following selection criteria

- Diploma (or similar) in occupational health and safety
- Relevant teaching experience in first or second level schools
- Experience in presenting to adults
- Appropriate IT skills
- Ability to work on own initiative

Candidates should be available to attend two full days training (familiarisation programme) or more as required. On completion of this programme tutors will work on their own initiative and independent of the Health and Safety Authority to deliver suitable training to teachers and to schools.

Tutors will be paid Department of Education and Science rates or as agreed with the Education Centre or and the relevant Board of Management. Tutors will make their own arrangements regarding all aspects of the delivery of the courses. No payment will be made by the Health and Safety Authority

Tutors selected for this panel will not be employees of the Health and Safety Authority. Canvassing will disqualify
